It was not until the late '80's that the Federal government passed legislation to work through the HUD Department to address veteran's homelessness. In the aftermath of the Middle Eastern wars, homelessness among vets remains a huge concern, according to Jane Vincent, who now heads the Mayor's Challenge to End Veterans Homeless in Delaware. The goal is to end all vets having to sleep on park benches, on city streets and back allies, in tents behind shopping centers, and in temporary shelters by 2015. Mayor Polly was the first mayor in Delaware to answer the challenge. She has identified 3 veterans in Newark who need homes and she is working to find low-income housing landlords who will help. There are 50 chronically homeless individuals in the Newark area.
