Jorge Camacho has long experience. Prior to ASPIRA, Mr. Camacho was employed by the Delaware State University (DSU) as a Police Officer since October 2014. He served as the Campus Relations Officer and School Resource Officer for the Early College High School (ECHS). Mr. Camacho has 23 years of experience in Crime Prevention through Environmental Design (CPTED). Prior to DSU, he served the Delaware State Police and retired after twenty years of service. During his tenure with the Delaware State Police, Mr. Camacho served as a Community Policing Officer, undercover drug detective, School Resource Officer, Recruiter, and Community Liaison for Sussex County. Prior to the Delaware State Police, he served in the United States Air Force for 16 years. Jorge discussed the perception of school shootings vs. preparation for gun violence in schools. He reviewed ALICE: Alert, Lockdown, Inform, Counter & Evacuate program used to train staff and students to prepare for any incident. He pointed out that we had a propped open door and asked how many

of us were aware of the exits. Having locked doors helps slow down an active shooter and helps create a better outcome. He also emphasized during evacuation grabbing our stuff doesn't matter. When asked, said he was in favor of school security officers and not arming teachers. His frustration is when schools get funds and do not spend them on security.
